



**NOTICE OF DECISION TO GRANT A PERMIT UNDER THE
HAZARDOUS WASTE (REGULATION OF EXPORTS AND IMPORTS) ACT 1989**

Pursuant to section 33 of the *Hazardous Waste (Regulation of Exports and Imports) Act 1989*, notice is given that special export permit AUH22-003 was granted to DGL Group Ltd (ACN 002 802 646), 201 Five Islands Road, Unanderra, NSW 2526 (Telephone: +61 2 4247 2100).

The particulars of the permit are as follows:

- (i) The proposed recipient of the waste is BNS Korea Co., Ltd, 126 Songrim-gil, Chungju-si, 27476, Chungbuk-do, Republic of Korea (Telephone: +82 10 89835278).
- (ii) The type of waste is lead waste and scrap (Basel Code A1160).
- (iii) The maximum quantity of the waste that may be exported is 3500 tonnes.
- (iv) The waste is to be contained during export in plastic lined jumbo bags, each weighing approximately 2.0 to 2.1 wet metric tonnes. These bags are to be directly loaded into standard or heavy duty 20-foot sealed containers, with a maximum weight of 25 metric tonnes without pallets.
- (v) The waste is to be transported by road to the port of export, shipped by sea, and then by road or rail from the port of destination to the recovery facility.
- (vi) The waste may only be exported during the permit period.
- (vii) The waste is to be exported to the Port of Busan, Republic of Korea.
- (viii) The waste may only transit the following ports and countries: Port of Brisbane, Australia; Port of Yokohama and Port of Osaka, Japan. No other transit ports are permitted.
- (ix) The waste is to undergo a recovery operation at the Yeonghanmetals Co., Ltd facility, 46-20 Janggigongdan 1-gil, Daegaya-eup, Goryeong-gun, Gyeongsangbuk-do, Republic of Korea (Telephone: +82 54 9565071).
- (x) The waste is to undergo recovery operation R4– Recycling/reclamation of metals and metal compounds.

The permit period is from 30 March 2022 until the last departure date of 29 March 2023. All shipments must leave the last Australian port before or on the last departure date.

The permit includes and is subject to conditions.
