The Yorkeys Knob Boating Infrastructure Project consists of the construction and operation of a new boating facility adjacent to Half Moon Creek Marina and Half Moon Golf Course at Yorkeys Knob. The facility has been designed to allow for the launching and retrieval of vessels in response to a boating demand study for North Queensland. The new facility will include a six-lane boat ramp, two floating walkways, a queuing beach, breakwaters, dredged basin, reclaimed car park, access road and fencing.

This proposal to expand underground mining operations at the existing Angus Place Mine in the Western Coalfields of New South Wales, 15 km north-west of Lithgow, New South Wales [EPBC Act referral 2013/6889 and variation to original proposal dated 12 September 2019] has been withdrawn (notification received 4 August 2021).
