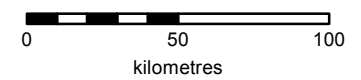


Distribution of the vulnerable green rosella (King Island) (*Platycercus caledonicus brownii*)

This distribution map was created using observation data from the Tasmanian Natural Values Atlas(DPIPWE), Birdlife Australia, and Australian Bird and Bat Banding Scheme(DotE) The known distribution comprises post-1999 observation points buffered by 250m. The likely distribution and possible distributions were predicted using the observation records, NVIS(DotE) detailed extant vegetation mapping. Distribution has been generalised to 10km. Distribution mapped by ERIN Mar 2014.
