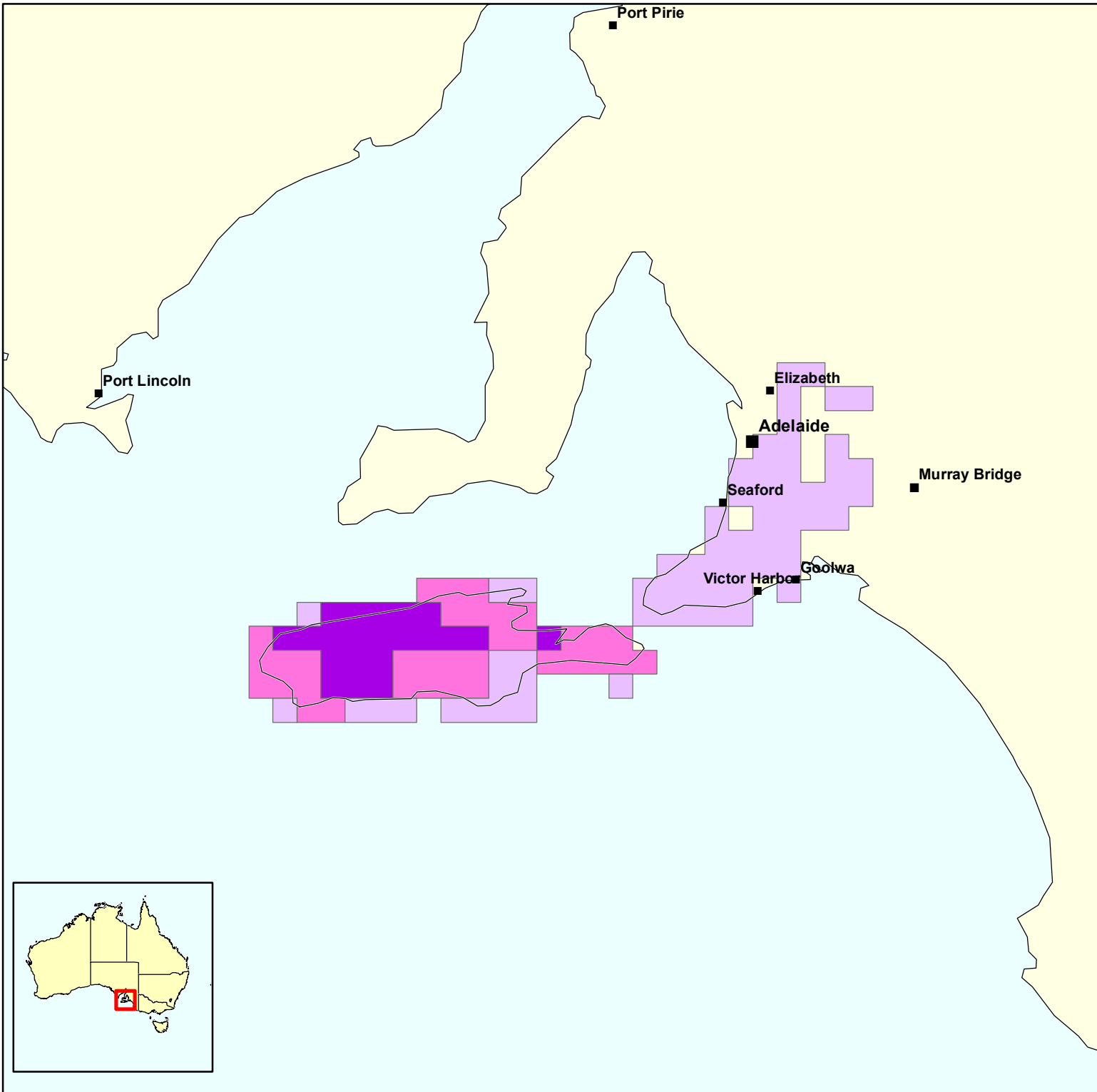


Distribution of the endangered glossy black-cockatoo (Kangaroo Island/South Australian) (*Calyptorhynchus lathami halmaturinus*)

This map shows the general distribution of *Calyptorhynchus lathami halmaturinus* as prepared by the former Department of Environment and Heritage-National Parks and Wildlife SA. In addition, foraging areas on the mainland were mapped and show areas that contain *Allocasuarina verticillata* and *Allocasuarina muelleriana* in the Southern Mount Lofty region. The map has been expert reviewed by Trish Mooney, SA Department of the Environment and Heritage. Distribution has been generalised to 10km. Distribution mapped by DEWNR(SA)
