Purpose

To inform exporters of the time frame and requirements required to submit end of voyage reports to the Live Animal Export Program (LAE) of AQIS.

Instructions

As stated in the Australian Standards for the Export of Livestock, all livestock exporters are required to submit an end of voyage report (EOV) to the Live Animal Export Program of AQIS, within five days of completion of discharge at the final discharge port for the voyage or flight.

An EOV report is required for each Livestock NOI/CRMP (LNC) number approved by AQIS. Where an exporter has multiple LNC consignments on one voyage, an EOV report is required for each consignment. The report must include all information stated in the ASEL Appendix 5.2 for sea voyages and Appendix 6.2 for air voyages.

The report must be legible and signed and dated by the appropriate qualified person for the voyage.

From 18 June 2007, if the report is not received within the specified time frame or does not include the required information, the LAE program will not approve any current or future NOI/CRMP's until the reports are received.

If an exporter does not meet this condition, they must provide a written explanation to the LAE program stating the reasons why they are unable to comply with this requirement.
