**Purpose**

To advise exporters of amended Indonesian government import permit requirements.

**Instructions**

Previously, the Indonesian government required an import permit for each importer on a vessel transporting cattle from Australia.

The Indonesian government has advised AQIS that import permits for feeder cattle will be issued for one port of arrival and one importer for a specific number of cattle during a 3 month valid period. This means that one import permit can be used multiple times during the valid period.

AQIS is not required to track the number of cattle exported using one specific import permit during the valid period.

A valid import permit may be presented to AQIS by more than one exporter (on one voyage or on different voyages). A copy of the import permit and NAATI certified English translation must be presented to the relevant AQIS officer before granting "Permission to leave for loading". A NAATI translation is not required if the import permit is presented in English. AQIS officers must check the details of the import permit including the valid dates and the port of import. AQIS officers must issue the export permit and health certificate to the entity listed on the import permit.

The revised arrangements are to be implemented when the exporter obtains the Indonesian import permit which is not "one consignment only".
